## **Livery Agreement**

This agreement is made on: (Date)	Between
The Heathstud, Lloyney, Knighton, Powys	And

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1. The Services

The Yard shall at all times during the Term provide the Services in an efficient and professional manner which meets the welfare needs of the Horse and in so doing will exercise all the skill, care and diligence that might be expected of a competent and properly qualified livery yard insured for care, custody and the control of horses. The Owner will notify the Yard in of any information or documents required by the Yard to enable it to perform the Services including without limitation, any known vices, medical condition, and any special requirements of the horse. During the Term, the Yard will keep appropriate records of all acts and works done by it in relation to the Services and at the request of the Owner, the Yard shall make them available for inspection and provide copies to the Owner. It is also the owners responsibility to insure their own contact details are kept up to date.

## 2. Facilities to be provided and duties undertaken by the Yard:

**Full Livery:** As for Part livery but includes excercising. (Full training Livery by arrangement) **Part Livery:** Feeding, watering, maintenance of box and bedding providing a bale of shavings per week. (extra bedding to be purchased from the yard at prevailing rate) Feed will consist of basic maintenance, feed and haylage, no extra supplements. Basic grooming. (Grooming kit etc to be provided by the owner) No clipping or trimming included. Daily turn out / grazing for a minimum of 1 hour (weather permitting). Worming, tooth inspection and vaccination are owners responsibility. All horses must be wormed on arrival & have vaccination certificates. veterinary, dental and farriers fees are the owners responsibility. Special requirements must be clearly stated.

Throughout the Term, the Yard shall give the Owner open access, during the business hours of the Yard, to the Horse and all the premises where the Horse is kept, access to the yard outside normal working hours is by arrangement with the yard. Rules or requirements relating to the yard as notified by the yard owner will be observed. During the Term, the Yard shall employ for the purposes of the Services sufficient persons that are suitably skilled and experienced, and where it is appropriate, professionally qualified in providing services as agreed. The Yard shall ensure that all persons wear appropriate dress at all times when in the vicinity of the Horses, conforming to BSI standards, and suitable headgear and footwear with a flat sole and heel.

## 3. Duties of the Owner

The Owner(s) shall ensure that the Horse(s) are provided with all those matters as set out in the schedules below detailing the responsibilities of the owner and the services provided by the yard, charges for use of services, a profile of your horse, and a daily breakdown of your horse's livery yard routine. In the event that the Owner fails to ensure that the horse is provided with any of the matters listed in the schedule, the Owner agrees that the Yard may undertake this work and charge the Owner in accordance with the sums set out in this Agreement, or where not covered by this Agreement, at the current market rate. Owners are advised that their horses should have insurance. Livery to be paid by one month in advance (or £100 deposit) Owners are required to give a months notice to leave the yard unless otherwise arranged. All liveries agree that in the event of an emergency, if they cannot be contacted, that they give a representative of The Heathstud permission to call a veterinary surgeon on their behalf who may need to administer euthanasia. Passports can be safely lodged at the yard (if needed) Vets and Farrier visits will be arranged and paid for by owners. Any assistance required such as holding a horse in case of your absence can be available by prior arrangement, and subject to payment being left prior to a visit. Although we take utmost care to ensure horses safety accidents do sometimes happen. We and other liveries cannot take responsibility for such accidents (If a horse kicks yours or any damage is caused at The Heathstud by yourself, your horse, your property or your visitors it is your responsibility) Cars and your property are left at your own risk and should be kept locked at all times.

In the event that the Fee or any additional sum due under this Agreement remains unpaid for more than three (3) months after they first become due, the Owner agrees that the Yard may sell the Horse, provided that written notice has been given to the Owner (at the address set out at the beginning of this Agreement) of the intention to sell, at least seven (7) days before sale. From the monies received from the sale of the Horse, the Yard may retain such sums as cover of any unpaid sums due under this Agreement and the reasonable costs of sale. Any remaining money shall be returned to the Owner within thirty (30) days of sale.
